The Comanche Nation's main headquarters is north of Lawton, Oklahoma, and our tribe has approximately 17,000 enrolled tribal members.

We serve as an extension of the Comanche Nation of Oklahoma acting as a liaison between tribal members and tribal programs. Our core services include referring all tribal members to the appropriate Comanche Nation department for their desired non-local service(s) and other programs or resources as necessary, assisting with the application process, providing applications and information to tribal members for their convenience, and keeping tribal members informed on upcoming and current Comanche Nation events. # SERVICES

## → Referrals

Refer all tribal members to the appropriate Comanche Nation non-local service(s) department, and other relevant programs or resources as necessary.

## → Application Support

Assist with the application process for Comanche Nation non-local service(s) and other programs, and provide applications &/or information to members.

## → News & Events

Offer outreach events and cultural activities, and keep tribal members informed on upcoming and current Comanche Nation events.

## → Peer Advising

Offer mentorship & guidance in navigating professional processes including completing applications for FAFSA, scholarships, college admissions, and more.

## → Career Planning

Provide assistance with career exploration & preparation including mock interviews, and reviewing resumes, cover letters, and portfolios.

## → Community Pantry

Our community pantry includes limited non-perishable food, water/juice, toiletries, clothing, shoes, and blankets which are available to all tribal members.
